Richard Harrold of Guilford County and State of North Carolina, do hereby make and ordain this my last will and Testament this 2nd Day of the 12th Mo 1837.

1st My Will is that all my last Debts and funeral Charges be paid by my Executors

2nd I Give and bequeath To my beloved wife One Mattress and Side Saddle One Corn & Call. One Feather Bed and furniture all now wearing appeared to her and her heirs forever also the Clock the Case and Sower with plate Enrichments to the Key holding the Loom and Jacks the Spinning Spinning the Cotton Captains with 12 light tin Tables Two of the Fatting Hogs and a Son and Pig with three Stock Hogs and the tin Waggon during her natural life

3rd I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Abigail One feather Bed and furniture and the property she bought at the sale of her Aunt Lams.

4th I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha One feather Bed & furniture and the few things she bought at said Sale

5th I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth One feather bed and furniture and the things she bought at said Sale

6th It is my will that my widow and all my Children have the Plantation whereon I now live for so long as they live single

7th It is my will that at the Death and Marriage of all my family that my land be equally divided amongst the surviving Children and the heirs of such as die having Issue the Accendant of One Child to have One Share

8th I Leave all my other Estate Real and Personal to the management and discretion of my Executors to divide amongst my Children

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9th I hereby appoint Nathaniel Mendenhall and Solomon Mendenhall
Executors to this my last will & Testament
