Richard Harroth of Guilford County and State of North Carolina do hereby make and ordain this my last will and Testament this 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of the 12<sup>th</sup> Mo 1837.

My will is that all my last debts and funeral charges be paid by my Executors

I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife One Matt and Side Bedstead One Corn & Cabb. One Feather Bed and furniture all now wearing appeared to her and her heirs forever also the Clock the Case and Sounding with Plate Escutcheons to the Key holes the Loom and Jacks the Spinning Amy the Cotton Cupboard with 12 Light tin Tabbles Two of the Fatning Hops and a Pen and Pig with three Stock Hogs and the two Waggon during her natural life

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Abigail one feather Bed and furniture and the property she bought at the sale of her Aunt Jane.

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha one feather Bed and furniture and the few things she bought at said sale

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one feather bed and furniture and the things she bought at said sale

It is my will that my widow and all my Children have the plantation whereon I now live for so long as they live single

It is my will that at the death and marriage of all my family that my land be equally divided amongst the surviving children and the heirs of such as die having issue the descendant of one child to have one share

I Leave all my other Estate Real and personal to the management and discretion of my Executors to divide amongst my Children
