 Give unto my Wife Sarah One Feather bed & One Chaff bed and
 their Furnitures and One Cow & Calf to her Choice & One Horse & all
 the rest of my property to be sold & my Just debts to be paid off &
 What remains Over paying my debts to be Equally Divided
 Amongst all my Children - As witness my hand & Seal this 21.
 day of September In the Year of Our Lord 1819
