my soul unto the hand of almighty God that gave it

Day his Touching such Estate that it hath pleased God
to keep me well in this life I give and dispose of in the
following manner first I give and recommend unto my
Beloved wife Mary all my Lands, during her life or

as an honest to sell the same for her use of it and
if she dont sell it I also allot it to go to Richards

Whaler my son I meseson at his decease or marriage and if
 She Should sell it and any part of the price Should her son in
 her hands at the time of her decease or marriage I want it goe
 to the Dr^r Richard also I give unto my beloved wife all my house
 hold tennement during her life or widow hood then st. for Decese
 or marriage for all my house hold property to be equally divided
 between my three daughters namely Anney Immes Sarah Chaple
 she and Elizabeth Massay.
