now live and have her Maintenance upon the Plantation where I now reside
during an widowhood and that my Father & Mother namely Allen & Sarah Mendenhall
have a home on the premises and have their Maintenance upon the Premises of the
same by me provided. Agreeable to a verbal contract between myself & my Father
above named for and in consideration of his interest in me by deed executed under
the sole right and title of the Land & premises where I now live to have
to hold the same for and in consideration of him & his wife Dinah being in fact
supported by me during their Natural life

And I will & bequeath to my son Samuel all my Land & Tenements with the Reversion
that he will & truly perform my Will as to the Maintenance & Accommodation of
my Wife Martha & my Father & Mother above named

And Lastly I do Ordain & Appoint my Wife Martha and my son Samuel Executors
to this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand this day & year above written
