dozen plates, Knives & Forks half dozen cups and saucers, half
dozen Table Spoons, & half dozen Tea Spoons the last named
articles during her life time

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsey M. Hatrick one Bay
Horse named Jack, Two Cows, Two Beds and Furniture, one Chest
and Wheel, one oven & Pot, Two Chairs half dozen cups & saucers
half dozen Knives & Forks, half dozen plates one pitcher. To her and
her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter William H. Hatrick one

half dozen knives & Forks. half dozen plates one pitcher. To her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally G. Hatrick one mare named Kate. and Fifty Dollars to make up for the difference of said mare value two cows, two pigs and furniture one chest & clock. One brass pot. Two chairs half dozen cups & saucers. half dozen knives & Forks. half dozen plates. one pitcher to her and her heirs forever

I give and devise to my son Daniel Hatrick the four hundred acres of land I bought of John Kicks. One Cornell Horse named Thom. Two cows. one pig and furniture. one chest, one Barr -
- Charr - Plough. one Shovel Plough. one pair of ears. one clock. one saw and pipe He the said Daniel paying to his four Sisters namely Betsy M. Sally G. Abby Hatrick and Anne Cornell. the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars to be paid to them or their heirs within fifteen Years from the probate of this will. the above named property. I will to him and his heirs forever.

I will and bequeath to my Daughter Abby Hatrick one bay

Filly. two cows. Two Bids and Furniture one Chest and Wheel. one
oven and pot. two chairs. half dozen cups and saucers. Half dozen
knives and forks. half dozen plates and one pitcher to her & her heirs forever

The Loom to remain in the loom house and my Daughters to have
the use of it while any one of them ~~remains~~ lives single.

My Books and Sheep to be equally divided among all my five children.
It is my will that at the death of my wife. that Sim be sold
the price of said Sim. and the one Hundred acres of Land which
I Bought of Charles A. Gillaspie which is not to be sold. and all
my Notes. and the residue of my unwilld property. and the
Seven Hundred Dollars which I allow Samuel to pay. is to be
equally divided amongst my four Daughters. Namely —
Betsey M. Hatrick Polly & Hatrick Abby Hatrick & Anne Dorrin
Chase and Chase Alike

Lastly) I hereby constitute and appoint my son Samuel Hatrick and
Col. James Derry — Executors of this my last will and
Testament Revoking all Will heretofore by me in any wise made
