

Will of Robert Landony, deceased

In the name of God, Amen, I, Robert Landony, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life, and being in perfect health and of sound mind and memory, stand be to God for the same, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as followeth:-

First: I allow all my just debts to be paid - I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Nancy all my stock of horses, cattle, hogs and sheep, all the utensils of husbandry that has been in use on the plantation, and all my household furniture that has been in use, also One Thousand Dollars - I gave unto my son, John two hundred and fifty dollars and to his children Samuel, Easter, Mary, Robert and Sarah, each of them fifty dollars. - I gave unto my son Samuel and fifty dollars - I gave unto my son Robert 75 tract

I gave unto my son Robert 5 tract
four as described in
this paper and plot annexed to
this, also two hundred and fifty
dollars - I gave unto my son
William one tract of land No 3. tract
as described in the paper before
mentioned - also two thousand dollars
- I gave unto my son Andrew
one tract of land whereon I now
live No 5 five as described in
the paper before mentioned, I allow
my wife, Nancy to have the use of
one half of said tract of land
including the improvements so long
as she continues my widow, I also
gave to my son Andrew one
tract of land No 1 one as described
in the before mentioned paper and
fifteen hundred dollars - I gave unto

my daughter Jeune one tract of land
No 2 two - as described in the paper
before mentioned - and two thousand
dollars - I gave unto my daughter
Elzebeth one tract of land No 6, six
as described in the before mentioned
paper, also two thousand dollars -
I gave unto my daughter Susanah
two thousand five hundred dollars
and all the remainder of my estate,
I allow to be equally divided
betwixt my wife and children,
my son John excepted, I hereby
appoint my beloved wife Nancy
Lindsay sole executor of this
my last will and testament
hereby revoking all former wills
by me made I re witnesses
whereof I have hereunto set my
