I being desirous of the unity of Suffolk and that of both boundaries being of
land and water and considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence
to make and declare this will and testament in manner and form
following that is to say

First that my venerable father give to my body a decent burial suitable
to the rank of my parents and station and pay all my funeral expenses by the
receipt of my last debts and of so many that just come into his hands as a piece
of part of my estate

Second I give and do give to my beloved wife Polly - Winney my two negro women her
life time and to be supported as she joins during her life her bed and furniture
and the use of all the silver plate & kitchen furniture during her natural life
to wit the remains of her

Third I give and do give to my son John the plantation with all its improvement
in which he lives forever.

Fourth I give to my beloved son Robert all the rest of my lands, negro, horses cows hogs
various tools Smith tools mill and property of whatsoever kind that I possess
to be his right and property and it is my will and desire that he should
enjoy in all things and I give my beloved wife and my sister Jane in a
joint tenancy

life time and to be supported in the same during her life her bed and furniture
and the use of all the Silver Stole & kitchen furniture during her natural life
or while she remains single

Item I give and devise to my son John the plantation with all its improvement
in which he lives forever.

Item I give to my grandson son Robert all the rest of my lands, negroes, horses cows hogs
carriages tools Smith tools mill and property of whatsoever kind that I possess
to be his right and property and it is my will and desire that he should
enjoy in all things and support my beloved wife and my sister Jane in a
beneficial and decent manner during their natural lives out of the profits
of the estate

And lastly I do make her child and appoint as her Robert my lawful Executor to
all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the
true intent and meaning and manner of the same and every part and clause
thereof hereby revoking and annulling all other wills and testaments
by me heretofore made

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the sixth day of November 1840

As the name of Robt. McHenry of Guilford County and State of North Carolina
knowing that it is appointed for him that he is and being weak of body, nervous and
of sound mind and memory do make and declare this to be my last will and testament in
manner and form following to wit

Item 1st I will that all my last debts and funeral charges to paid out of my estate

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my son John McHenry one hundred dollars in money to be paid
over to him within six months after my decease by my Executor

Item 3rd I allow my Executor to sell and my daughter-in-law Sarah McHenry for the support
and benefit of her & family my lands and tenements together with all my stock and chattels
