New Hampshire being sick in body but of sound mind & memory blessed be God to this sixth day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five. make and publish this
my last will and Testament in manner following: I do commend my soul to God that gave it
and as concerning my worldly affairs that God hath blessed me I shall dispose of them in the
following manner (viz)

I give and bequeath to Margaret Mitchell my beloved wife the one third part of all
my lands and Tenements and also one half of all my cattle (viz) Horses cows & sheep and one
half of all my other movables with the House I now live in during her natural life and at her
death to be disposed of at her discretion either to her son Adam or her Grand son Robert Mitchell.

I give to my son Adam the two thirds remaining parts of my lands

I give to Mary Hop and Isaac Anders son of my Daughter Leah five pounds

I give to my Grand son Robert Mitchell eighteen pounds

I give to my youngest Daughter Rebecca the other one half of my cattle (viz) horses cows &
sheep and movables and one half of all my money and book debts after my ~~deaths~~ death.

I make and ordain James Tenney & Robert Rankin my sole Executors of this my last will
and Testament in Witness whereof I set to my hand and seal the day and year above written.

My Body & the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors
and as concerning my worldly affairs that God hath blessed on me I shall dispose of them in the

1st I give and bequeath to Margarett Mitchel my beloved wife the one third part of all
my Lands and Tenements and also one half of all my Chattle (viz) Horses Cows & Sheep and one
half of all my other movables with the House I now live in during her natural life and at her
death to be disposed of at her discretion Either to her Son Adam or her Grand Son Robert Mitchel

2nd I give to my son Adam the two thirds remaining parts of my Lands

3rd I give to Mary Hop and Jean Anders son of my Daughter each five pounds

4th I give to my Grand son Robert Mitchel Eighteen pounds

5th I give to my youngest Daughter Rebecca the other one half of my Chattle (viz) horses cows &
Sheep and movables and one half of all my money and Book debts after my ~~referred~~ debts
debts and burial Expences are discharged and the other half to my beloved wife Margarett and
her heirs and ordain James Lenny & Robert Rankin my sole Executors of this my last will
and Testament In Witness whereof I set to my hand and seal the day and year above written
