 or Marriage Remove them and to have what every One of  
 them has purchased as their Own I Give & bequeath to  
 my Son Robert Wiley all the Lands that I possess except  
 One Hundred Acres which I allow him to sell or keep in  
 his Own hands & Give the price to my Son Matthew and  
 David Wiley One Hundred Dollars to Each. I also bequeath  
 to my Son Robert Wiley my Still & brandy and Corn purchased  
 from Sedarick Whimmy and what wheat can be spared out  
 of the family to pay my just debts. I also Bequeath to my  
 Robert Wiley One black Boy named Peter which I allow him  
 to keep in the family. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter  
 Jean One black Girl named Amy. I also allow her to pay Esther  
 Abby and Anna Wiley fifty Dollars to each my two Old black Ones  
 Peter & Katy. I allow to Remain on the Plantation amongst my children  
 all my Stock & Farming utensils. I allow to Remain on the plan-  
 tation if my Daughter Mary I allow them two Cows each to my  
 Son Robert Wiley I bequeath my Desk & books and to my Daug-  
 hters Also I allow each of them One Horns creature if they marry  
 & my Dresser furniture to be equally divided amongst my  
 Daughters this I acknowledge to be my last Will & Testament Given  
 under my hand & Seal this 12 day of October 1819

under my hand & Seal this 12 day of October 1819.
