

In the Name of God Amen. I Roddy Hanson of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina, being weak in body but of sound & disposing Mind and Memory, I knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain this as my Last Will & Testament in manner & form as follows. First It is my Will that all my Just Debts be paid.

Secondly I Give & bequeath to my son John Hanson all the Land I have already deduced to him also a Negro boy named Hannan, together with all the other property that I have Given to him already.

Thirdly I Give and bequeath to my son Robert Hanson all the property which I have given to him including a Tract of Land deduced to him by Robert Hanson & also a Negro boy named Isaac.

Fourthly I Give and bequeath to my son Elie Hanson all the Land which I have hitherto deduced to him together with all the other property already given him.

Fifthly I do hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friends Rodger Hudson, Alexander Hanson and my son John Hanson Executors & Guardians for my son Edwin Hanson and upon the death removal or Refusal to act of any one of them, the other two shall appoint or fill up the vacancy by appointing another to whose Care and Management I leave the following property for the benefit and support of my said son Edwin Hanson aforesaid and they are hereby directed to act in all things respecting this Trust either directionally or Legally as they may discover it but for him the property as follows all the Land whereon I now live and one Negro Woman named Pib the two pairs of Fine Sows One Barshar Plough, One Shovel Plough, One bull Tongue Plough, One bit of Harrow horse, One Ox, One Iron bridge, Two Cows, One bit of double Fress, Two beds & furniture, the Cupboard & furniture, Two Walnut chests, One Walnut Table, Four Chairs, Two Cows & Calves, One hog, the Broom, Man & Redford Horse, and the Cooking Utentials that belong to the House & Kitchen, Six Head of Hogs. Two Choice, and Two Sheep, all of which property the aforesaid Guardians are to Manage for his benefit and if he should have any legal heirs they or their Successors are to deliver over to them at his death, or if he the said Edwin Hanson should die without any legal representatives as heirs the property or the income that may be left after supporting him is to be sold by them and equally divided to said heirs if such if none then they are to divide

No make and Ordain this as my last Will & Testament in
follows.

First It is my Will that all my Debt & Debts be paid.
Secondly I Give & bequeath to my son John Hannon all the Land I have
already deduced to him also a Negro boy named Hannon, together with
all the other property that I have Given to him already.

Thirdly I Give and bequeath to my son Robert Hannon all the property
which I have given to him including a Tract of Land deduced to him
by Robert Hannon & also a Negro boy named Isaac.

Fourthly I Give and bequeath to my son Eli Hannon all the Land which
I have hitherto deduced to him together with all the other property already
given him.

Fifthly I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my worthy friends Rodger
Hudson, Alexander Hannon and my son John Hannon Trustees & Guardians
for my son Edwin Hannon and upon the death removal or 'Refusal' of any
of any One of them the Other Two shall Appoint or fill up the Vacancy
by appointing another to whose Care and Management I leave the
following property for the benefit and support of my said son Edwin
Hannon aforesaid and they are hereby directed to Act in all things
respecting this Trust either directionally or Legally as they may discover.

It but for him the property as follows all the Land which I now
live and one Negro Woman named Pitt the two pair of Iron Bars One
Barstool plough. One shod plough, One bull Tongue plough, One set
of Hannon's hors. One Ax, One Iron bridge, Two Chives, One set of double
Tress, Two beds & furniture, One Cupboard & furniture, Two Walnut chests,
One Walnut Table, Four Chairs, Two Cows & Calves, One keeper, One Cow
Man & Bedford Horse, and the Cooking Utentials that belong to the
House & Kitchen, six Head of Hogs. Two Choices, and Two Sheep, all of which
property the aforesaid Guardians are to Manage for his benefit and
he should have any legal him they or their Successors are to deliver
over to them at his death, or if he the said Edwin Hannon should die
without any legal representatives as him the property or the income
that may be left after supporting him is to be sold by them and
equally divided to said him if such if none then they are to divide
the same among my four Children. To wit John Hannon, Robert Hannon
Eli Hannon & My Wife, or if any of them should die the Children
of the deceased to them receive the part that their Father or Mother would

be entitled to share and share alike.

Lastly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Abby Field all the property I have hitherto given her including a Negro Girl called Leahy and a Negro Woman named Mamet Rachel, it is my Will & desire that the Balance of my Negro be sold, to wit, Cuss, George, Abby & Martin & the Amount of the Sale to be divided as follows Eli Hanner is to have One hundred Dollars first, and the balance of said sale to be Equally divided between my sons John Robert & Eli Hanner My Wife and desire is that Roddy Hanner son of John have Ten Dollars and Noah Hanner son of Robert have Ten Dollars and that Roddy Fidas son of my daughter Abby have Ten Dollars in Cash out of my Estate, and that my Grand daughter Sally Field have my bed & furniture, and that my Grand daughter Sally Pauline Hanner have Ten Dollars in Cash, and that Robert's daughter Sally have the bed & furniture I bought at Eli Hanner's sale—

The Balance of my ~~estate~~ property not mentioned in this Will is to be sold and Abby Field to have Twenty five Dollars and Edwin Hanner to have Twenty Dollars the balance to be Equally divided between John Robert & Eli Hanner my sons

Lastly I hereby Nominate and appoint my son John Hanner & Paul Cobb Executors of this my last Will & Testament—Revoking disannulling all other Will or Wills hitherto by me made Confirming this and this only to be my Last Will & Testament

have One hundred Dollars first, and the balance of said sale to
be Equally divided between my sons John Robert & Eli Hanner
My Wife and child is that Roddy Hanner son of John have Ten
Dollars and Noah Hanner son of Robert have Ten Dollars and
that Roddy Fidds son of my daughter Abby have Ten Dollars in
Cash out of my Estate, and that my Grand daughter Sally Fidd
have my bed & furniture, and that my Grand daughter Sally
Carline Hanner have Ten Dollars in Cash, and that Robert's daughter
Sally have the bed & furniture I bought at Eli Hanner's sale.

The Balance of my Estate properly not mentioned in this Will is to
be sold and Abby Fidd to have Twenty five Dollars and Edwin
Hanner to have Twenty Dollars the balance to be Equally divided
between John Robert & Eli Hanner my sons

Lastly I hereby Nominate and appoint my sons John Hanner
& Paul Coble Executors of this my last Will & Testament— Nothing
disannulling all other Will or Wills heretofore by me made
Confirming this and this only to be my last Will & Testament
