I Samuel Lennins of the County of Guilford in the State of North Carolina being weak & frail of body but sound of mind & memory Calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is Appointed for all men once to die; Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form as follows: Witness first & principally of all I recommend my soul to God who gave it, & my body to the dust, to be buried in a decent Christian burial not doubting but that I shall receive the same again by the almighty power of God. — at the General Resurrection.

And as touching my Worldly Estate, which it has pleased God to bless me with, in this life, I Will & devise, the following manner. —
1st I Will & devise to my three Sons Thomas, John, & William Lennins, the Land I have heretofore given them, for which they have settled, also all their other property.
2^d I Will & devise unto my three Sons Samuel, Robert, & James Lennins the remainder or other half of land to be equally divided among them & I hereby Order & direct my Executors with one other person by him chosen to make such a division, as will be just & equitable among them. — I also Will & devise unto them ^{that} unto Samuel a note on A Ryall for forty three Dollars, & Twenty one Dollars I have heretofore given him to make him up in price of a horse Ceterum, & I Will & give to my Son Robert a young bay Mare, & to my Son James a Young black Horse —
3rd And I Will & devise unto my daughters each a Bed & furniture, Excepting my daughter Isabel, as she has already got One, & I Will & devise unto all my daughters to each, One Cow — I also Will & devise unto my four daughters

Mary, Jane, Sally, & Ruth Cimmins. One Hundred & Thirty Dollars
in Cash, to make them equal with their sister Isobel, for property
I have heretofore given her, & Value the same to that amount.

I will & desire that the remainder of my estate
if any, together with my distribution share in my sister Ann's
estate be equally divided among all my few Daughters.

It is my Will & desire that my Children now with me shall
live long & friendly & peaceably as brothers & sisters did it is my
Will that they have out of the provisions on hand, what will
support them for one year - & all the Cotton on Hand -
to make them Clothing -

And I hereby constitute Authorise & appoint my
sons Thomas & Samuel Cimmins Executors of this
my last Will & Testament. In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal
this 10th day of February 1826.
