 Mill together with my dwelling house & other out buildings thereon with all my house
 & kitchen furniture (except four beds & bedding) Also I Give to my wife & Son William
 Fountain two cows each to have an equal share or right in the same during my
 Wife's life, & at her death I Give the same to my son William, I Give to my wife my
 Black Mare to dispose off as she thinks proper. Item I Give to my Son William
 Fountain his Horse Saddle & Bridle, with what other property he may have at my death. Item
 I Give my Three sons Andrew John & Eli Fountain the balance of my land lying
 East of the above mentioned road to be equally divided between them I Give
 to my son Andrew Fountain his Horse Saddle & Bridle Wagon & two set of Gears, One
 bed & bedding One Wheel Fan with all the other property he claims as his own. Item
 I Give my son John Fountain his Horse Saddle & Bridle one bed & bedding two pair of
 Wagon Wheels which is not put together with all the other property he claims as his
 own Also I Give my son John my Working Desk. Item I Give to my son Eli
 Fountain his Horse Saddle & Bridle Blacksmith ~~Shop~~ Shop Tools, One bed & bedding with all the
 other property he claims as his own. Item I Give my daughter Elizabeth Follen the
 Cow & calf she now has of mine. Item I Give my daughter Mary Ann Harvey
 the Cow & calf she now has of mine. Item I Give to my son in Law Anseland
 five Shillings. Item I Give to my daughter Sally Fountain my black mare & calf,
 One bed & bedding her Saddle & Bridle also One Cow & calf.
 What Cattle property will be over what is bequeathed in this Will at my
 decease I wish to be sold & divided equally between my four sons William
 Andrew John & Eli Fountain.
