Thirdly - I give unto my three daughters Mary Sarah and Kessiah Heaths an equal divide of all my moveable property to be given them at their mother's death or marriage and if ^{it} should be that my wife has a girl it is to have an equal share with its sister as above.

Fourthly - I give unto my brother Ralph Heath all my Smith tools.

I do appoint for my Executors my wife Festin Heath and my brother Ralph Heath
