 Shillings sixthly I Give and Bequeath to my son David Gymbert  
 five Shillings seventhly I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter  
 Sarah Mack five Shillings eighthly I Give and bequeath to  
 my son William Gymbert five Shillings ninthly I Give and  
 Bequeath to my son Charles Gymbert five Shillings Tenthly  
 I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Leah Russell five  
 Shillings Eleventhly to my son Richard Gymbert five Shillings  
 also it is my Will that at my Wifes Death my Land be equally  
 Divided Between my sons Samuel and John Gymbert With  
 Equal advantage as near as possible to both also it is my  
 Will at my Wifes Death all the Movable property be sold  
 and Equally Divided Between all my Children Lastly I do  
 appoint Charles Gymbert and William Maybin Executors of my  
 Last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have to this my  
 Last Will and Testament set my hand and seal this Day  
 and Year above Written signed publicly by the said  
 Gymbert testifies as his Last Will & Testament
