2nd I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Stanley all of that plantation on which we now live during her lifetime provided she lives longer than I do & also One Horse, a cow & stock, farming utensils & household furniture sufficient for a comfortable support, after her decease the said land & property is to constitute & make a part of my Estate & be divided with the rest as I shall hereafter direct, Now the life of the said Sarah should she see the same or a part thereof she may do so with the advice & assistance of my Executors who shall take care of the proceeds thereof & keep it for her use or as much of it as will be necessary for her comfortable support her lifetime.

live, with all the houses, out houses, Orchards, & Meadows, with the remain-
ing part of my stock of all kinds, with my best Waggons & harness, also
Carriage & harness, with the remaining part of my farming tools and
Carpenter's tools, Also my household Kitchen & Cupboard furniture, &
with my Negro Charles. Lucy & her two youngest Children Emeline
& Workman, for her entire use & benefit during her lifetime or wid-
Item 4. At my wife's decease or Intermarriage I direct that my Ex-
ecutors see the remaining part of my Estate & divide the Money &
the four Daughters above mentioned
