Bunday being weak in body yet of sound disposing mind & memory
do make & Ordain these presents to contain my last Will
& Testament in manner following to wit.

1st I Give to my daughter Mary Smith Ten Shillings current.

2nd I Give to my Son Nathaw Bunday One Clock & Case two beds,
& furniture, One Cow. Three head of Sheep to him & his dispo-
sal.

3rd I Give to my Grand daughter Sarah Smith One feather bed &
furniture to her & her disposal.

4th I Give to my Grand daughter Mary Smith, One feather bed &
furniture to her & her disposal.

5th I Give to my Grand Son Eric Smith One feather bed &
furniture, One case of Drawers, One Chest of Drawers, One falling
leaf Walnut Table, One Iron Pot, One frying pan, One Dutch Oven
One pair of drawers & One hundred Dollars to him & his disposal.

6th I leave all the remainder of my Estate to be sold by my Execu-
tors & that my last debts be paid, & the balance to be deci-
ded as follows, that is to say my Son Nathaw Bunday
have the One half of the said balance, & the other half
of it to be Equally divided amongst my three Grand
Children namely. Sarah Smith Mary Smith & Eric Smith
to them & their disposal.

And furthermore I do hereby nominate & appoint my Son
Nathaw Bunday Guardian to my abovesaid Grand
Children Sarah, Mary & Eric Smith to take care of
the property for them bequeathed in this Will.

And lastly I Nominate & Appoint John Bell &

Phineas Albertson Executor of this my last Will & Testament this
25th of the 5th month 1816.
