 I Give unto my son William Spruce five Shillings
 I Give unto my son Joseph Spruce five Shillings
 I Give unto my son Quinter Spruce five Shillings
 I Give unto my son Thomas Spruce five Shillings
 I Give unto my daughter Sarah Train five Shillings
 I Give unto my son George Spruce One Negro Girl named
 Sally also one feather bed & Furniture and Discharge
 him from the payment of all the Debts due from him to
 me by Note or otherwise — I Give unto my Daughter
 Polly Spruce One Negro Girl named Lark With all the rest
 of my beds and those furniture also all my stock of cattle
 Horses and all my household & kitchen furniture of every Description
 whatever I appoint and Ordain George Spruce my Executor to
 this my last will & Testament Given Under my Hand and
 Seal this 22nd day of November. A.D. 1818
