In the name of God Amen. This 27th day of
March 1821 being in sound mind & memory but
calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing that
it is appointed for all men to die. I do hereby make
and ordain this my last Will & Testament. In the first
place I recommend my soul to God who gave it. & my
body to be buried a decent manner

- 1st Item I lend to my beloved wife Two Hundred acres of
land, & two Negroes One man Robt. One Girl named
Amey. & all my household furniture & two Choice
Horses that I have at my death, & two Cows & Calves
& all my stock of hogs. & all my Crop of Grain & fodder
that I have on hand at my death, the two hundred acres
of land mentioned, that I lend to my wife is where I
now live, & the above mentioned property, Except the
Grain I lend to my wife during her life or widowhood
- 2nd Item I give unto my beloved son Joseph Harrell after the
death of my wife the two Hundred acres of land that
I lend to my wife & one negro Boy named Yorks One horse
saddle & bridle One bed of furniture One Cow & Calf and
two Ships freely to enjoy forever
- 3rd Item I give unto my beloved son Stephen Harrell One hundred

acres of land where he now lives besides other property which he has already received fully to enjoy forever. —

Item I Give unto my beloved Son Henry Harrell the Sum of Three Hundred & thirty Dollars which I have settled for him 48 Crag mare which he has already received One feather bed & furniture and Cow & Calf freely for him to possess & enjoy for ever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Son David Harrell One hundred acres of land lying on the east side of Dickson Road, one bed & furniture, One Cow & Calf One Horse & cart free to possess & enjoy for ever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Underwood One Negro Girl named Ginney which she has already received & other property which she has already in possession freely for her to possess & enjoy forever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Atkins One Negro Girl named Filler which she has in possession beside other property which she has in hand received freely for her to enjoy forever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Daughter Rachel Harrell and Negro boy named Caleb, One Hundred Dollars after my Death One feather bed and furniture One Cow & Calf freely for her to possess & enjoy forever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Daughter Abigail Harrell One Negro Girl named Cinah One feather bed & furniture One Cow & Calf freely for her to possess & enjoy forever.

Item After the death of my wife Elizabeth Harrell I Give unto my beloved daughter Martha Calman the Sum of Three hundred Dollars freely for her to possess & enjoy forever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Son John Harrell One hundred acres of land lying on the west side of Dickson Road where Henry Harrell formerly lived, One feather bed & furniture, One Cow & Calf One Saw Ship & One Horse which has been, freely for him to possess & enjoy forever.

Item I Give unto my beloved Son James Harrell One Negro man Sam One Horse bridle & saddle One bed & furniture One Cow & Calf One Saw Ship & cart for him enjoy forever.

Item all the property that I have not killed away nor lent

mare which he has already received One feather bed & furniture and
Cow & Calf Truly for him to possess & enjoy for ever.

6. I give unto my beloved son David Harrell One hundred
acres of land lying on the east side of Dickson Road, one bed &
furniture, One Cow & Calf One Horse beast free to possess
enjoy for ever.

7. I give unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Underwood One
Negro Girl named Ginney which she has already received & other
property which she has already in possession truly for her to
possess & enjoy forever.

8. I give unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Atkins One negro
Girl named Filler which she has in possession beside other property
which she has in hand received truly for her to enjoy forever.

9. I give unto my beloved Daughter Rachel Harrell and
Negro boy named Celeb, One Hundred Dollars after my Death
One feather bed and furniture One Cow & Calf truly for her
to possess & enjoy forever.

10. I give unto my beloved Daughter Abigail Harrell
One Negro Girl named Cinah One feather bed & furniture
One Cow & Calf truly for her to possess & enjoy forever.

11. After the death of my wife Elizabeth Harrell I give unto my
beloved daughter Martha Calmard the sum of Three hundred
Dollars truly for her to possess & enjoy forever.

12. I give unto my beloved son John Harrell One hundred
acres of land lying on the west side of Dickson Road where
Henry Harrell formerly lived, One feather bed & furniture, One
Cow & Calf One Saw ship & One Horse which has been truly
for him to possess & enjoy forever.

13. I give unto my beloved son James Harrell one
Negro man Sam One Horse bridled saddle one bed & furniture
One Cow & Calf One Saw ship truly for him to enjoy forever.

14. I leave all the property that I have not Willed away nor lent
have it to settle all my last debt & to raise money to settle
with the legacies that has money left to them.

Lastly all property that is lent to my Wife & not given away
at her death, I give it to be equally divided among all

my children except Elizabeth Underwood Sarah Adkins
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day
& date above written.
