 my Widow & then to have full possession — It is also my
 will & desire that my son Thomas Pembow have my tract
 of land lying on Horse pen Creek, & some tools & take
 two Hundred Dollars in Cash — It is also my will
 & desire that my two daughters Sarah & Anne Pembow
 have each of them One feather Bed & furniture & one
 hundred Dollars apiece, — It is also my will &
 desire that my son Charles Pembow have the dolly
 the reason why, I leave my son Charles no more is
 because he has heretofore had his portion.
 It is also my will & desire that my daughter Elizabeth
 Thompson have ten shillings, the reason why, I leave
 my daughter Elizabeth no more is because she has had
 a part of my Estate before
 It is also my will & desire that my sister Elizabeth Clayton
 have the house & twenty acres of land where she now lives

 that all my property not herein disposed of to be equally
 divided between my wife & three daughters.

my daughter Elizabeth no more is because she has had
a part of my Estate before
It is also my will & desire that my sister Elizabeth Clayton
have the house & twenty acres of land where she now lives
during her natural life — It is also my will & desire
that all my property not herein disposed of to be equally
divided between my wife & three daughters.
I therefore appoint my sons Charles Bentow & Wm Bentow
to be whole & sole Executors to this my last Will & Testament.

2^d I recommend my body to the Earth from whence it came, not doubting but what my Executors will bury it in a decent & Christian like Manner, and as to this worldly Estate with which It has pleased God to bless me I Give and dispose of in the following Manner Viz. Item 1st I Give and bequeath unto my beloved

Son John Blair the sum of Twenty Shillings

Item 2^d I Give and bequeath unto my beloved son James Blair the sum of Twenty Shillings

Item 3^d I Give & bequeath unto my beloved son Samuel Ruth Blair the sum of Twenty Shillings

Item 4th I Give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Martha Blair the sum of Twenty Shillings.

Item 5th I Give and bequeath unto my beloved son Thomas Blair the sum of Twenty Shillings.

Item 6th I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Parmar the sum of Twenty Shillings.

Item 7th I Give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Blair all that tract of Land, where I formerly resided or so much thereof
