Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Carby being about leaving the State of North Carolina, do grant & let to my house & plantation in Caswell County N.C. consisting of One hundred & twenty five Acres and my house & plantation in Currituck Co. N.C. consisting of One hundred & thirty seven Acres more or less to my nephew Thomas Carby, now residing in Brunswick Currituck Co. N.C. with all appurtenances therunto belonging; to hold, possess and manage said plantations as his own, provided neither of them be sold by me before my departure from N.C. And if the said Thomas should die without issue then his sister Justice Brown & her issue by both Carby or her issue now residing in New York shall become right full heirs to said plantations. And all other property belonging to me in America I grant bestow, and bequeath to my said nephew and in failure of issue to my said Niece according to the above disposition in case of my death in the United States in as full a manner as if I specified all money and other articles belonging to me, now in my possession or lawfully due to me, provided however that this grant and

dispositions shall be of no avail till my departure from North Carolina, or in the event of my death in said State, or in any other State of the Union
