Grace of God of sound mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will
& Testament in manner & form following
First I recommend my Soul to God that gave it & my Body to
be earthily buried.

I give unto my beloved wife Hepzibah Davis all my estate both
personal of what kind or nature soever that is to say the use, profit &
enjoyment thereof during her widowhood and if she should incline to marry again
my will is that from that time she have no more than one third part of the use
& profits of my estate & if wife should marry again my will is that two
thirds of our household goods be divided equally amongst my three daughters
Elizabeth, Lydia & Elisabeth & if she should not marry again my will

is that at his house all my household goods be given to my wife & my
step-son & daughter.

All the residue of my estate of what name or nature soever I give
into my son and namely John Thomas, Peter & Thomas at my wife's
survivor or devise.

I hereby do make & appoint & ordain my wife Hannah Davis
and Executors of my this my last will & Testament.
