two daughters Miss Rebecca Hamilton and Hannah McLean And with respect to my two
sons Pance and his wife Phoebe I bequeath them to my daughter Hannah
McLean and she is to add to the amount of the sale of my other Property

the sum of three hundred dollars and if they are not willing to live with the
said Hanson so that they may have the privilege of choosing a Master for them-
selves which said Master will be bound to pay the estate of three thousand one
hundred dollars payable at the same time the money comes due of my other
