And at the death of my sd. wife I give, devise and bequeath to my sd. son Thomas Dennis all and singular my lands and Tenements, goods and chattels whatsoever and wheresoever the same may or shall be found to him my sd. son Thomas Dennis his heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I do make, ordain, constitute and appoint my son Thomas Dennis my full and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament,
