 as she remains my Widow. And to my eldest Daughter Sarah I
 give one Cow One bed & one spinning wheel. And to my daughter
~~Mary~~ Mary One Cow One bed & one spinning wheel. And to my daughter
 Rebecca in like manner One Cow One bed & one spinning wheel.
 And all the rest of my personal Estate to my loving
 Wife during the time she remains my Widow
 And lastly I do make & constitute my Wife and
 John Beard Executors of this my last Will &
 Testament Written with my own hand this fifteenth
 day of the Seventh Month in the year of Our Lord
 One Thousand Eight Hundred & twenty five.
