of my last will and testament

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Starbuck of the County of Cumberland
and State of North Carolina being in a feeble state of health, but of sound
Mind and Memory, do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner & form following.

I will that all my Real Estate and Personal Charges be paid in good
Season out of my Personal Estate.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Starbuck the use and
benefit of my Plantation where I now live and the Plantation that I
bought of Benjamin Fells with all the Privileges and Appurtenances thereto
belonging, undisturbed while she remains my widow. It is also my
will and desire that my beloved wife have the use and benefit of
all my household and Kitchen Furniture and all of my Personal
Property not hereafter disposed of (while she remains my widow)

I will and bequeath to my son Thomas Starbuck, all that tract or
parcel of Land where he now lives in Stokes County on the Waters of
Blues Creek adjoining the lands of Benjamin Coffin and others containing
One Hundred and fifty eight Acres to the same more or less to him
his heirs or assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Milton Starbuck all that tract or parcel
of Land where he now lives on the Waters of Rudy Fork adjoining
the lands of Ruben Starbuck and others containing One Hundred
thirty Acres of Land to the same more or less to him his heirs or
Assigns forever.

I will and bequeath to my Daughter Abigail Henry fifty Dollars in Cash.
I will and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Starbuck One Hundred Dollars
in Cash, One Trunk bed and furniture, One Piano with glass Mountain
One Cow and a Bay Mare called Bessie after she weans the calf.

that she is now well

I have I will now bequeath to my two youngest sons Edward and Bejamin all the lands that I have leased to my Beloved wife after she is done with it which is all the land I am in possession of except the two lands given to my two eldest sons to be equally divided between the said Edward & Bejamin. It is also my will that my two youngest sons have each of them a Colt or horse raised out of my stock of horses at the time they become twenty one years of age. It is also my will that all the remainder of my personal property after my Wife ceases to be my Widow be equally divided between my two youngest sons Edward & Bejamin then and there about.

And Lastly I appoint and constitute my wife and my son Thomas Starbuck to execute the my last Will and Testament signed sealed & acknowledged in the presence of us the 28th of the 12th Mo 1838.
