

do this Second &c. of November in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty Nine make and publish this my last Will & Testament in Manner following that is to say.

First I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Webb the sum of Four Thousand Dollars to be taken out of the best of my Notes at as early a period as my Executor is qualified to transact business also I do give her my Negro boy Nathan, my desk and Book Case also all the present she hereunto hath in or Manages to be had and at her disposal forever.

Secondly I do give and bequeath unto my unborn embryo of my wife the sum of Four Thousand Dollars the Tract of Land that I bought of George Cornell, and that portion of the tract of Land which I bought of George Chuteau, lying west of the branch running from the Widow Buchanans River land through to East and so on to the head of my meadow & through the same.

Thirdly I do give and bequeath unto my brother Silas Webb the plantation on which he now lives with all what Notes and Accounts I have & hold against him.

Fourthly I do give and bequeath unto William Webb son of Silas Webb the plantation I hold known by the Name of the Hartford Place adjoining the place where Silas Webb now lives.

Fifthly I do give and bequeath unto William Schofield the plantation on which he now lives known by the Name of the 2d. Norman place & Forty two Acres or thereabouts lying between sd place & Wrennash which I bought of Robert Coffey.

Sixthly I do give and bequeath unto Sarah M. Oliver who is intermarried with my Son Peggy or Margaret Webb that portion of my Land which I bought of Joshua C. on which my dwelling house is situate containing Two hundred Acres reference being had to the End of the Lands I bought of sd C. for the boundaries, also a piece of Land I bought of Robert C. Rankin and the residue of the tract remaining unsold which I bought of William Machin by his giving up all the Claims he has & holds against me both of Notes and Accounts and I do also give him the Lower title in my Mill house and all my Mill vessels also a corral mare now called Nis.

Seventhly I do give and bequeath unto John Charlton Husband of my Sister Rhoda the residue of the Land which I bought of Joshua C. described in the last which the sixth Clause of this my Will refers to to be in

Also that portion of the said Tract of land lying east of a Branch running from the Wilson Branch to the upper end of my Meadows and joining the before described piece and the piece to the piece left to reach all Acreage also the sum of Three hundred Dollars with which I desire him to buy a Negro Woman to add my late bread upon my children as to the children of my Brother Almeda Webb. It is my will by them Executing to Joseph Springer a Tract of land sold by Almeda Webb due to Samuel Webb and then sold as the property of Samuel Webb by virtue of a deed of Trust at which sale the said Joseph Young became the purchaser that Isaac Webb son of Almeda Webb have the plantation which I bought of Elijah Childs, and that same with the second son of Almeda have the Tract of land which I bought of James Childs and the sum of One hundred Dollars and that the three daughters of Almeda Webb have each the sum of One hundred Dollars. Monthly as respects my late property, I have excepted it is my will that they be valued by three judicious disinterested men and permitted to take a purchaser each for it say at the set price to whom, my Executors shall be clear in executing a Title under the virtue of their Office at as high as it and such if any as cannot find a Purchaser to be valued together and sold together as Black woman and her two children to be valued together and sold together - thus, and I do give my Negro known by the name of Old Thomas, recently five Dollars, I do give Jacob, Isaac, & David, each five Dollars. I do give Mayor, Doctor, Little Thomas, and Nathan each five Dollars. Finally I do give and bequeath unto my Bond due me by Joseph Allen and six hundred Dollars out of a Bond due me by Joseph Allen and comes out of no other part of my Estate. Otherwise I do leave give and bequeath the sum of Fifty Dollars to be appropriated to the use of repairing the Bridges or Daughatup Meeting houses, or other building a New Meeting house at sd place. I do also leave the sum of Fifty Dollars to be applied in purchasing Marble and pla the same at the head of my late Wife Darius Webb my late Brother Almeda Webb & his late Wife and my own being four in number, or in case not getting Marble conveniently, some other good quality of stone. I make discretionary with my Executors. Lastly. As to all the rest of my Estate of which I may die seized I will that it be sold, which now consists of stock of Hinds, of Hens, Household & Kitchen furniture, Waggon, Farming Utensils

And I hereby Make and Ordain my Two Friends John Wharton & Noah all Crier Executors to this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby put them with full power in Case any dispute arise about rights of property to settle the same without being liable for not carrying it through a Course of Law as to them may seem best. In Witness whereof I the sd. Thomas Webb have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my Seal to this my last Will & Testament the day and year first above Written
