Publish this my Last Will & Testament, in Manner following that
is to say.

I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth her maintenance of or my plan-
tation during her life or widowhood, and also my boy Mary, and
One Cow, also her choice of One of the beds and furniture also my
Clock, and the Flax spinning Wheel, and Dutch Oven, & Tea Kettle,
& two of the best Chairs, and the side dindell, also my Desk, to be
at her disposal.

I give & bequeath to my son Border the tract of Land wherein I now live
at the death of my Wife, or Marriage to him & his heirs forever,

I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Fifty Dollars

I give & bequeath to my son Henry Ten Dollars. My Will is that the
balance of my Property be sold and the Money arising therefrom
be equally divided amongst the balance of my Children not named.

And I hereby make and Ordain my worthy son Henry Executor of this
my Last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I the said Thomas
White have to this my Last Will & Testament set my hand and
seal the day & year Above Written
