

I Timothy Morgan of Guilford County & State of North Carolina being of sound mind and disposing memory do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following (imprimis) it is will that all my Just Dues be paid

First I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Morgan the use and profit of all the Land I own in this County during her natural life I also give my wife the use of my Negro man named Joe with the use of One good Horse & Plover during her natural life I also give wife Two Cows & Calves One bed & Furniture and Part of my best Hogs & such other household Furniture as Executors shall Judge necessary for her comfortable Support.

2nd I Give unto my Daughter Lucy Becken five Shillings I Give it to her & her heirs forever

3th I Give unto my Daughter Mary Mathews the Sum of Five Shillings I Give it to her & her heirs forever

4th I Give unto my son Elias Morgan Thirty Acres of my Land to be taken off of the South West Corner of my Land that joins Elias line I Give it to him & his heirs forever

5th I Give unto my Daughter, Celah Mills the Sum of five Shillings, I Give it to her & her heirs forever

6th I Also Give unto my son Thomas Morgan the Sum of five Shillings I Give it to him & his heirs forever

7th I Also Give unto my Daughter Martha Morgan the Sum of five Shillings, I Give it to her & her heirs forever

8th I Also Give unto my son Nicholas Morgan the Sum of five Shillings. I Give it to him & his heirs forever

9th I Also Give unto my son Green Morgan all the balance of the Old Tract of Land (that called the Hams place) except what I have heretofore Give to my son Elias my will & Meaning is for Green not to take Possession of the Land during his mothers Natural Life unless She Give her Consent.

I Also Give unto my son Green all my Stock of Horses Hogs & Cattle Sheep & Hogs. Except what I have heretofore Given to my wife I also Give Green my Set of Blacksmiths Tools. I Give all the Above mentioned to him & his heirs forever

10th I also Give unto my Grandson Once Morgan that Tract of Land that John Ham bought of Isaac Stanley known by the Name of the Stanley Piece I Give it to him this being for ever It is my will & meaning that all the Land that I own in Wake County (on the White Oak Creek) be sold by my Executor, It is my will that my wife have all the Residue ~~My~~ for her use & benefit During her Natural Life.

It is my will & meaning that After my Wifes Decease that my Negro man by the name of Jo. have his freedom be a freeman Clear of any Claim of any of my heirs of what ever name or nature And Lastly I do make constitute & Appoint my Son Elias Morgan & Abel Coffin Joint Executors to this my Last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 28th of May 1818.
