McCuskin the tract of land that I now live on! that is to say to have full possession of it at my death to him his heirs & executors assignes to hold the same forever. Third I give & bequeath to my beloved son Robert M. McCuskin One Walnut Chest & my family Bible. Fourth I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Granddaughter Levina M. McCuskin my Household furniture at my death. Fifth I give & bequeath to my Grand daughter Jane Johnson One large Dutch Oven. Sixth I give & bequeath to my Grandson Walter Johnson One bay Horse Colt now two Years old at my death.

Seventh I give & bequeath to my son Thomas M. McCuskin at my death my Waggon & Cars of farming tools, & all other Property not disposed of at my death.

I hereby make & Ordain Thomas M. McCuskin my son & William McCuskin Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I the said Walter McCuskin have to this my last Will & Testament, set my hand seal, the day & year above written signed, sealed, published & declared by the said Walter McCuskin the Testator, as his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof
