considering the uncertainty of life and that it is appointed unto man once to die I  
heartily make and publish this my last will & testament in manner and form following  
My body I leave to the Lord to be buried in a Chancel like Maum & my soul  
to the God who loveth And as to my worldly goods I dispose of them  
in the following manner viz:

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I will and bequeath unto my beloved son Gabriel Allbright a part of  
My Land bounded as follows Beginning at My beginning corner running  
thence with my line S. 45° E. to the stream then down the same to the  
Mine Hole thence to a lower corner the beginning corner of Messrs Gould  
thence S. 25° W. to a white oak on the bank of the creek thence to the beginning  
be the same what it may

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I will and bequeath to my beloved son John Allbright the remainder of  
said tract of Land bounded as follows Beginning at the creek a corner  
of Gabriel's part running thence S. 45° E. to a Hickory Lewis Lower corner  
thence South 45° W. to a Hickory thence S. 45° E. 2000 yds. to a oak tree then  
N. 120 to a oak tree then N. 20 W. 82. to a Hickory then N. 25 W. to  
Gabriel's corner thence with his line to the beginning be the same what it

Yahel's corner then with his line to the beginning is the same what it  
may.

Item 3<sup>d</sup>. I will and bequeath to all the children of my blood Daughters  
Catherine Hoover Equally amongst them that Parcel of Land known  
by the name of the Porter Place bounded as follows Beginning at B. oak  
Runny. thence N. 47.° E. 130 poles to a P. oak. thence 170 to P. oak Great  
then S. 47.° E. 56 poles to Hickory then to the corner containing twenty  
five acres Excepting also acres that John Bondy is to have

Item 4<sup>th</sup>. I hereby Publish & declare that my sons Samuel & David Southam  
Jacob. & Henry Albright & my daughter John Southam have received  
the following sums of money that I to pay

Samuel four hundred & thirteen - David three hundred & eighty  
three Jonathan four hundred and twenty & a half Jacob two hundred and forty  
one, Henry four hundred and twenty - And I have also given each of them  
and twenty four - Like wise each of these my sons above named  
that one hundred. Now concerning these my above named children  
I order and direct that if the Sale of my property shall amount  
to more to each of my children not here named but using my

Item 4. I give to my love of Eight Hundred dollars that the above  
 money shall be made equal as I will hereby direct  
 Item 5. I order & direct that all my Property shall be sold by  
 my Executors & the money arising therefrom the sale equally  
 divided amongst my three surviving to each what they have  
 already got

Item 6. I will & bequeath to each of my sons Gabriel & John One horse  
 Item 7. I order & direct that all my last Debts be forthwith paid off  
 by my Executors

Item 8. And last I hereby appoint and ordain my son Gabriel  
 Albright & Jeremiah Hays my Trusty and faithful Executors  
 In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand & affixed  
 my seal this 12 day of June 1834.
