Wheron I now Live which I Give to Adam for the Support of my Wife
and Children to be enjoyed as follows for my wife Jane to have the said
plantation Wheron I now Live for the Support of the same Children
During her Life or Widowhood & at the Expiration of either she is to be one
of said Lands and the Land to be Equally divided among my five
Children and further all the Money which will over pay my Debts
to be Equally divided among my Wife Jane & the Children if there is
a surplus of said Money and for the children to have their
portion of the Land as they come of age this I William Brown do
declare to be my Last & firm Will & Testament. Living in Guil-
ford County & State of North Carolina Whereto I do appoint
Benjamin Brown and Eliza Martin my Executors in
Witness Whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal
the day and date above Written in the presence of interline
and attested in presence of the Witnesses.
