 Beloved Wife Lucy A Buell a Tract of Land or a part of a tract
 Whereon I now live beginning at a black Oak in Cotes line running
 thence West to the lower Side of the field adjoining said Cotes Plantation
 thence straight South till an East Course will strike a white Oak
 corner in Archibald Whiteworths line during her natural life or
 widowhood, then to my Beloved Sons Vivant & Joel I Buell
 to them & their heirs forever also I give an bequeath to my Wife an
 Negro Woman by the name Sue during her natural life or widow-
 hood & if the sd negro woman has any increase the first one
 if any bequeath to my son Joel I Buell & if the said Negro Woman Sue
 has any more increase after One She & They to be Equally Divided
 Amongst my Children that is to say Vivant & Joel I & Elizabeth
 Buell & if She & the Negro Sue never from this has no Children the is to
 be paid to Octon & the money to Equally be divided amongst my Child-
 ren, Vivant, Joel I. & His Elizabeth Buell, I give a bequeath to my
 Wife One Bed & furniture one Cupboard Furniture, Item 3 I give and
 bequeath, to my Beloved Son Vivant Buell One half of the rest of
 my Land to him & his heirs also I give One negro boy called Bedford
 to him & his heirs forever Item 4th I give & bequeath to my beloved
 Daughter Allyo Buell One Negro Girl called Harry & her heirs
 forever One Bed of furniture, Item 5th I give & bequeath to my beloved
 Son Joel I Buell the balance & all of my Land to him & his heirs & One
 Horse by the name of Lucifer which horse is to remain on the plantation
 of my wife Lucy Buell till the Said Joel I Buell arrives to the
 full age of Twenty One Years & at my decease for my son Joel
 I Buell to be bound to Alexander Buell as an Apprentice to learn
 the Black Smith Trade till he arrives to the age of Twenty One years
 And the Said Alexander Buell to Learn the said Joel I Buell to Read &
 Write well & to Cypher to the Double Rule of Three & When the said
 Joel I Buell arrives to the age of Twenty One the said Alexander Buell
 to give the said Joel I Buell One set of Black Smith Tools Two suits
 of Clother One of Working Clother & the Other suit of Store Clother
 Item 6th I give & bequeath to the said Alexander Buell

Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my
Beloved wife Lucy A. B. will a Tract of Land or a part of a tract,
Whereon I now live beginning at a black Oak in Colles line running
thence West to the lower Side of the said adjoining Colle Plantation
thence straight South till an East corner will strike a white Oak
corner in Archabald Whiteworths line during her natural life or
Meadowhood, then to my Beloved Sons Twain & Joel I B. will
to them & their heirs forever also I give an bequeath to my wife the
Negro woman by the name Lucy during her natural life or widow-
hood & if the sd negro woman has any increase the first one
if any bequeath to my son Joel I B. will & if the said Negro woman shall
has any more increase after One She & they to be Equally divided
Amongst my Children, that is to say Twain & Joel I B. & Elizabeth
B. will & if she & the Negro Lucy never from this has no Children she is to
be paid to Octon & the money to Equally be divided amongst my Child-
ren, Twain, Joel I. & Elizabeth B. will, I give a bequeath to my
Wife One Bed & furniture inc Cupboard Furniture, Item 3 I give and
bequeath, to my Beloved Son Twain B. will One half of the rest of
my Land to him & his heirs also I give One negro boy called Bidford
to him & his heirs forever Item 4th I give & bequeath to my beloved
Daughter Ally B. will One negro girl called Harry & her heirs
forever One Bed of furniture, Item 5th I give & bequeath to my beloved
Son Joel I B. will the balance of all of my Land to him & his heirs & One
Horse by the name of Swigge which horse is to remain on the plantation
of my wife Lucy B. will till the said Joel I B. will arrives to the
full age of Twenty One Years & at my decease for my son Joel
I B. will to be bound to Alexander B. will as an Apprenticeship to learn
the Black Smith Trade till he arrives to the age of Twenty One Years
And the said Alexander B. will to Learn the sae Joel I B. will to read &
write well & to cypher to the Double Rule of Three & when the said
Joel I B. will arrives to the age of Twenty One the sae Alexander B. will
to give the said Joel I B. will One set of Black Smith Tools Two Suits
of Cloches One of Working Cloches & the Other Suit of Store Cloches
Item 6th I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth B. will
One negro girl called Pig to her & her heirs forever One Board

furniture One Horse Called Carter which is to Remain with her
for her maintenance of her & the Negro Girl Peg to be Turned Out
Until the 1st Elizabeth Buell Comes of Age & Thirty Dollars of the
Hire to go to Schooling of Elizabeth Buell - 173 That the p[re]mises of
Land Which I Give to my Wife During her Natural Life or Widow
hood shall be Divided Equally between my Sons as before mentioned
by Setting the Comparts in the middle of the Spring & Run in So as
to make an Equal Division to them - & all the balance of my
Personal Property to be Sold at Auction Except One Chair Provi
sion for my Family and the Proses of Sale if any After my
Just Debts is Paid to go to my Wife.

Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty One
