 yet mentioned & to also direct to be sold by my Executor and applied
 to paying the several sums of money to my children here mentioned & the
 surplus of the money of said sales to be divided equally among
 my Children And I do hereby appoint David Thomas my true & lawful
 Executor of this my last Will & Testament to which I have
 set my hand and affix my seal this 11th day of October in the year of
 our Lord 1823.
