 Whatsoever and all Every thing that Belongs to me and to
 me And to be there At my Decease —
 I Do Appoint for my Executors my Brother James Criswell
 And my friend Daniel Connell to see this my Last Will &
 Testament Executed
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand (and
 Affixed my Seal this 12 day of April in the Year of
 Our Lord 1816

 my Estate To be Equally divided Between
 my Brother & Sister as above mentioned
