In the name of God and I William Demmy being in the State of
North Carolina Guilford County and I being sane and Memory
Do make this my last Will and Testament - this Eight day of
June 1826 and it is as follows viz.

First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Jane Demmy
my house to live in and the one there is my Land that I own
proper to her own use as long as she lives or is a widow,
and also two cows one Horse the three of the Hogs and two
Teasels, two milk pails two Mowing Machines and one Walnut
Table and cupboard and five other plates two Cakes of Butter
and one pot and Dutch oven.

and Tom's Daughter Mary Ann I give and bequeath one Horse
saddle and bridle and two Teasels, two Mowing Machines two cows
and eight six plates and one butter cake a set of Table knives
and forks and those articles that she bought I allow her to keep
for her own use -

and unto Elizabeth Demmy and Samuel Demmy my two
eldest sons and Rebecca Demmy my youngest Daughter I give
and bequeath one Dollar to each of them in addition to what they
have already got and unto my youngest son Walter Demmy I
give and bequeath unto him all my Land at the Ocean
of my Wife except two acres of Land near the House and
five Woods and the use of the House for Mary Ann Demmy my
eldest Daughter as long as she lives single or on the place
I also unto Walter I give Horse saddle and bridle -
and unto Walter & Mary Ann I give the Wagon and unto
Walter the Farming Tools -

I do hereby appoint and ordain my son Walter Cuming
to execute this my last Will and Testament, as Witness
my hand and seal the day and year above written
signed sealed and delivered in the
presence of us

being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby certify that this
is my last Will and Testament as follows: First my Will is
that my last Debts and Funeral charges be paid -

Secondly my Will is that the mill and mill lot of Cyprian
acres that is my two thirds thereof being all I claim should
be equally divided between my three sons namely John
Almoner and Jonathan White and my three plantations
in the same manner likewise being that I bought
of Lewis Almonerhall also to be equally divided between
the same three sons if they ever agree amongst themselves
if not for them to choose some of their neighbors
to do it, for them to advise their Deceased Wife not
to go Court thereby my Will is that my Trust
of Lane Spring on meadow Creek being what is
called the old Joe Shewey Tract I have given the said
below the said allowing Trust sufficient to contain
the same I give to my three daughters namely Teresa
Mathey Levery Susan and Hannah Thomas to be
received by them or their heirs
