Ninthly I do also give & becometh unto my youngest son Allen Denny all that remains of my estate from the above becomethments with the plantation on which I now live together with one hundred acres of Land lying on the northern of Middle Fork Road is the tract of Land I gave my son Wm Denny with all the appurtenances belonging to each tract of Land which I give my son Allen Denny his heirs & assigns forever — Lastly I do hereby constitute make & ordain my well beloved son Allen Denny and George Rankin my respected and trusty friends & Brothers in Law Executors of this my last will & Testament & I do Ratify and confirm this Deed & other to come I do well and in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year above writing
