 said Wife all my stock of Hogs & sheep to go the use of the family.
 I further Wish all my Negroes to be hired out yearly until my youngest
 child comes of age and the Store of them together with the rents &
 profits of my lands to go to the said Wife & to support of my
 Family & when my youngest child comes of age I Wish the Negroes
 to be equally divided between my four children Abigail Jane Edmund &
 John. My Will is also further is that all my lands be Equally
 divided between my two sons Edmund & John and like wise all my
 accounts & debts that are owing to me I Wish to be Equally divided
 between my two sons Edmund & John & all my other property not here
 mentioned except what comes to me is on hand I Wish to be sold
 & the money Equally divided between my two sons Edmund & John
 I further constitute nominate & appoint my Trusty friend John
 Springfield my whole & sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament
 Revoking disallowing and disannulling all and every other former
 Will or Wills Executor or Executors lately or hereafter made by me
 Only to be my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal this day above signed above written
 signed sealed & acknowledged

Dividends of my Lands to go to the schooling & support of my
Youngest & when my Youngest child comes of age I Will the same
to be equally divided between my four children Abigail Jane Edmund &
John. My Will & desire further is that all my Lands be Equally
divided between my two sons Edmund & John and like wise all my
accounts & debts that are owing to me I Will to be Equally divided
between my two sons Edmund & John & all my other property not here
mentioned except what comes & great is in hand I Will to be sold
& the money Equally divided between my two sons Edmund & John
I further constitute nominate & appoint my Trusty friend John
Armistead my Whole & sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament
do hereby disallowing and do annulling all and every other former
Will or Wills Executor or Executors saying and confirming this & this
Only to be my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have
