 Divids of my Estate to go to the said Children & Support of my
 Family & when my youngest Child comes of age I wish the Ints
 to be equally divided between my four children Abigail Lane Edmund
 John & my Wife & draw further is that all my Estate be Equally
 divided between my two sons Edmund & John and like wise all my
 accounts & debts that are owing to me I wish to be Equally divided
 between my two sons Edmund & John & all my other property not here
 mentioned except what comes present in hand I wish to be sold
 & the money Equally divided between my two sons Edmund & John
 I further constitute nominate & appoint my Trusty friend John
 Simpfeld my whole & sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament
 do hereby disallowing and disannulling all and every other former
 Will or Wills Executor or Executors of any kind and bearing this & this
 Only to be my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have

& the money Equally divided between my two sons Edward & John

Arncliffe my whole & sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament
