furniture.

Thirdly I will bequeath to my Grand son William Dickson
son of Robert Dickson One hundred acres of land con-
taining the House & Orchard Subject to John half of the
Orchard for the Term of Ten years, I will also that
my son Robert Dickson have his life time on the place

Fourthly I will bequeath to my Grand son James Dickson
the balance of my land. I also will that my Carpenter
tools, Cooper tools & farming tools be equally divided between my
Three Sons. I also will that my Books be equally divided
amongst my Children. I also will that my Goods and
Chattels be sold & my last debts be paid. and the balance
of the profits be equally divided between my two daughters
Nancy Pilkinton & Marthens Idetol.
