In the Name of God Amen, I William Montgomery of the State of North  
Carolina and County of Guilford being in health of body and sound in mind have thought  
proper to make this my last Will and Testament revoking and disannulling all former  
wills by me made ~~where~~ or by word of mouth and this only to be my last will and tis  
witness in manner and form as follows-

First I give and bequeath unto my wife Hannah Montgomery one third part  
of all my moveable Estate and to have the Plantation on which I now live at her  
disposal during her natural life or widowhood.

I give to my Eldest Son William Montgomery one Silver dollar

And unto my Eldest Daughter Frances Buchanan one Silver dollar

And to my Eldest Daughter Mary second Daughter I give one Silver dollar

And I give unto Hannah At night one Silver dollar

I give unto my Daughter Mary one horse and saddle one bed and furniture

And I give unto My son John Montgomery all my Smith tools  
And unto My son David I give all my Lands namely the Plantation or what  
I now live on at his Mother's house or manage the land I bought of John Gilchrist  
and the forty five acres I entered between Edmund Heylamore John Gilchrist and  
self and said David is to have all the moveables that is not willed away already  
and further said David is to pay unto his sister Rebecca's child called James  
I have taken under my care the sum of fifty pounds hard money to be paid unto  
her when she arrives at the age of Eighteen years and David is to settle all my  
both Debt and Credit out of Legacy and as to my books I desire them to be given  
as follows to Francis Buchanan M<sup>r</sup> Lamoch's book upon the divine attributes  
To my son John the same a Father on Regeneration - and the remainder of the books  
to be divided Equally between my wife Hannah and my son David - And further  
I desire that in case my wife Hannah should marry that she take her part  
my moveable Estate and give up the house and Plantation with my son David  
My wife's share of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth  
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Six  
Witnesses John Gilchrist, Samuel Gilchrist, Robert Gilchrist &c
