Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Post, One bed & furniture & bed sheet, One earthen dish, half a dozen plates, One Cow & Calf, to her & her heirs forever.

Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Eliza Post, One bed & furniture, & bed sheet, One earthen dish, half a dozen plates, One Cow & Calf, to her & her heirs forever.

Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Post, One bed & furniture, & bed sheet, One earthen dish, half a dozen plates, One Cow & Calf, to her & her heirs forever.

Item. It is my Will that all my household & kitchen furniture that is not herein otherwise disposed of be sold immediately after my decease and Equally divided amongst all my daughters namely, Deborah, Rachel, Margaret, Mary, Eliza, Nancy, Post & Post alike.

Item. It is my Will that the residue of my Estate, be sold by the Seller of the proceeds, paid over to my daughter Nancy Post when she arrives to the age of eighteen years & the balance of said proceeds to be equally divided amongst all my Sons, to them and their heirs forever.

And Lastly I do make Ordain & Constitution my Sons William Post, & Stephen Hussey, Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and I do hereby disallow disincent, & revoke, all former Wills, or Wills, legacies or legacies, executors or executors.
