 I will that my son A. Weatherly my executor with his
 Mother to see to the Plantation Creeds and Middling to see that
 that dear thing is properly distributed for support Always &
 yearly to them and their Produce or any thing more than is
 reasonably laid out in his support & maintenance for Executor and
 Executrix to see to the faithful managing of and all other
 things belonging her and reasonably paid themselves for their living
 as in the Case and it may be said either in Philadelphia
 however safe I might for he agreed all his me Daugair City
 Properly that was roane here when father his death & left
 Master without Doctor and in Care has his Father with
 him and had a Coal on this must be contented as I have done
 as much for him as I can convenient I advanced money thru
 a few times of his request & my own private means Execution
 Now I think by God's grace and Management the plantation in
 sufficient to raise & educate Master and the remainder to be at
 the Wilsons disposal at his death among his heirs to son of
 the Stock of his or Cattle I should give to a summaus that they
 may an engine sell them off and the money arising from
 the sale equally divided to Master & others above Daughters &
 wife Eliza Mary and Franchy I set think them do more in
 the next I put my hand & seal the 1824.

A Paper (Writing) purporting to be the Last Will & Testament of William Weatherly Esq^t late of Guilford County by his Short Name Humberly 1.2.3.1668, bearing date 1824. Without being Subscribed being Exposed to the Court for Probate Mr Justice being examined as witness along thereto by being called. Sworn the deponent sayeth that the said paper is upon Writing wherein found where the Deceased kept Valuable property and other effects. I am further witness in a quiet lot I mark Weatherly being also called as witness and duly sworn before that they are acquainted with the handwriting of the said William Weatherly & that all the Writing on the said paper is in the proper hand (Writing) of the said William Weatherly.

It is therefore adjudged by the Court that the said paper were the Last Will and Testament of the said William Weatherly Esq^t and that the same be recorded.
