 Charles Swan to have and to hold unto the
 Said Elizabeth Ray and Phoebe Mowers and their
 heirs forever.

3^{dly} I bequeath to the Granboro Lodge of Free &
 accepted Masons the sum of one hundred dollars
 to be paid out of my estate.

4^{thly} I devise to my Wife Rebecca Swan who has
 long lived separate from me (and who deserves
 nothing at my hands) one third part of my
 estate in the State of North Carolina during
 her natural life and no longer I also bequeath
 to the said Rebecca Swan one third part of my
 personal estate after the payment of my last debts.

5^{thly} I Devise I bequeath to Mary Swan alias Mary
 Memmophy to whom I have been married and
 with whom I received a considerable amount of
 property (and who has long lived with me in the
 capacity of an affectionate and faithful Wife)
 the whole residue of my estate both real and
 personal of whatever Nature or kind it may be
 or whatsoever I am to have & to hold unto the
 Said Mary Memmophy Swan alias Mary Memmophy
 and assigns forever.
