my will this; I give to my grand daughter Sarah McCulloch these slaves Warren
David, Flora, their children, Martin, Susetta Spick and Peggy and their future
Increase to her, her heirs & assigns - I give to my grand daughter Mary McCulloch
these slaves Mary & her children Henry & James Robin & Patsy their future increase
to her, her heirs & assigns. - I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth McCulloch
these slaves Willis & Nell Hasty, children, Phil & his children Maria, Donah
Child & Edie & their future increase to her heirs & assigns. - I give to my grand
son Samuel McCulloch these slaves Flora & Sam children of Amarrills, Sargie son
of Adinok, Supter, Grace & Dora the Waggoner and their future increase
to him his heirs & assigns - I give to my grandson Benjamin McCulloch these slave
Lucy & Hasty's daughter Daphne & Lucy & David & their sons of Amarrills Mark &
their future increase to him his heirs & assigns - I give to my grandson Alexander
McCulloch these slaves Roger & Mary, Duke, Will, Amarrills Archy, York, Green with
Cesar, William, son of Lucy, Abner & Leffry and their future increase to him
his heirs & assigns I also give to the said Alexander McCulloch my Land and
plantation & mill in Warren County to him his heirs and assigns forever
he is likewise to have Duke the miller this wife Silla the crop of ~~land~~ &
stock of horses, cattle, &c and tools that may be on said plantation when I die
I also give to the said Alexander McCulloch my negro woman Grace and her

I give to my Grandson Alex under Trochook a Wench named Grace and her
Children which are in his possession to him his heirs and assigns— I give my
man Phillip to Willie Jones & his assigns— Thereby direct my Executors herein
after named or either of them to sell my household Kitchen Furniture, the
Crop, my Stock of cattle Horses &c. Tools and implements of Husbandry that may
be on my plantation in Halifax County, to raise money for the payment of
my debts, I also direct authorize & empower my Said Executors or either of them
to sell and convey such part or parts of my Land in Halifax County as they or
either of them may think proper if it should appear to be necessary to raise
a further sum for the payments of my debts or if it should be found expedient
so to do for the more easy Division of my Estate because I choose that Land should
be sold rather than Negroes— I give the remainder of my Estate of every kind
real & personal including the following Negroes (to wit) Allen, Little Dick, Gabriel, Elijah
Mutalle Billy, her son Dick, Daniel, Francis, Phil, Mary, Sabina, Mahala, Josiah King,
Hesly, Penny, Isaac, Arthur, Nancy, Pompey, Bob, Jacob, Brumfield, Sallie, Jett
David, Nancy & Edenton and their future increase after payment of my debts
to my Grand Children, Alexander, Lemuel, Benjamin, Sarah, Mary & Elizabeth McCulloch
to be ~~equally~~ divided equally among them Share & Share alike to them their heirs & assigns

If any or either of my Grand Children mentioned in the preceding clause should die before they arrive at the age of twenty one or marry: That the Legacies herein given to him her or them shall be equally divided among the survivors to them their heirs and assigns — Lastly I appoint John Baptist Ashe & William Jones Executors to this will hereby ratifying all wills by me here before made In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & seal this 5th day of June 1795

I Alexander McCulloch of Halifax County do this day of 1797 make & publish this Codicil to my will — I give & bequeath my Lands included within the following limits to my Grandsons Samuel & Benjamin McCulloch Vizt: beginning in my line in the marsh swamp near the bridges thereon Along the road leading to Halifax Town to the run of Little Swamp then the meanders of the run up to the head of said Swamp then North to my west line then Along my lines & John Purnells to the run of the marsh swamp then meanders of the run to the beginning and the said Lands are to be divided between the said Samuel and Benjamin thus — hence the compass in the middle of the line which divides the

beginning and the said lands are to be divided between the said Samuell and Benjamin thus - I place the Comps in the middle of the lane which divides the plantation, call it the Old Place from the plantation whereon I live run ^{the lane of the lane} westward ~~to the~~ ~~Swamp~~ then reverse the course and run Eastwardly to Little Swamp and this shall be the line of division and I give the upper part being the Land Plantation whereon I live lying north of the dividing line to my Grand son Samuell McCulloch his heirs and assigns and I give the lower part lying to the south of the dividing line to my Grandson Benjamin McCulloch his heirs and assigns for ever - I authorize my Executors or either of them to sell and convey my Land within the following bounds to raise money to pay my debts, beginning at the run of Little Swamp in the Halfat Road then along the road eastwardly to Lunford Longs line then north his line to Willie Longs line then nearly the same course along Longs lines to the road which lead from Halfat Town to my house then along the road to Samuel McCullochs east line then south or southwardly along his line to Benjamin McCullochs line to the beginning I have annexed this Certificate and it is to be considered as a part of it to all intent & purposes In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written -
