& ample power to Sell & Dispose of my Estate after my Dec^d for
the Benefit of my above Mentioned Daughters as they may think just

 Item. I Give to my second son. Joseph One Cow & calf —
 Item. I Give unto my Eldest Daughter Sally Bails five shillings
 Likewise five shillings to my Daughter Bithiah Milikin Likewise
 I Give five shilling to each of my Daughter (twitt) Agnes
 Hartwell. Mary Susannah, Polly. & Betsy —
 Item. I Desire that my well beloved wife Mary Capmore may
 have the use of my Plantation & the Land belonging it & all
 the rest of my Goods & Chattles During her Life & After her Decease
 the 2^d Land & Plantation to be Right & property of my youngest
 son. Alexander Capmore Likewise I Desire that after her Decease
 all the Rest of my Goods & Chattles may be divided
