I give Devise & Dispose of in the Following manner & form —

First, I Give to my well beloved wife Mary Vick's My Land & Living
During her life or widowhood & at her Death or Marriage my Personal Estate
to be Equally Divided Amongst all my Children the Land Laying on the
Branch Springing from me since when the manner Plantation is I give to

to Die & make to ordain this my Last Will & Testament that is to say
Primally & first of all, I give & Recommend my soul unto the Hands of
Almighty God that gave it & my body I Recommend to the Earth to be
Buried in Decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Exor. Nothing
Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate
where with it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me in this Life
I give Devise & Dispose of in the following Manner & form —

First, I Give to my well beloved wife Mary Vick's My Land & Living
During her life or widowhood & at her Death or Marriage my Personal Estate
to be Equally Divided Amongst all my Children the Land Laying on the
Branch joining Bynum's Line where the Manner Plantation is I give to
my Son Benjamin Vick at my Wifes Death the other Part of my Land which
is in Dispute I give to James M. Mullan & Josiah Vick to be Divided
as they shall Agree I likewise Appoint Jesse Wayne & James M. Mullan
My whole & sole Exor. to this my Last Will & Testament & in Witness
