 ever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Coley one
 Hundred ~~and~~ two acres of Land which is the tract I now
 live on be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever
 also my Horses, Cattle, Sheep and hogs and all my house hold
 furniture to wit Beds and furniture Tables, Chairs, Cupboards, &c.
 to him and his heirs for ever reserving at the same time a
 maintenance for my loving wife out of the above property
 during her natural life and to give the same upon my son

Charles, to support and take care of his Mother during her natural life I do hereby appoint my friend Wood J. Hamblin and my son Charles Coley my lawful Executors in testimony hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of June 1807.
