In the Name of God. Amen. I Christopher Haynes of the County of Halifax & State of North Carolina, being sick of Body, but of sound and memory, do ordain this my last will & Testament as followeth. I bequeath my Soul to God that gave it, & my Body to the Earth to be there decently buried according to the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as for what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to intrust me with, I give, devise & bequeath in manner as followeth. I think I will that all my just Debts, & funeral Charges, be satisfied, and Paid.

128. Item. I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Lucy Haynes, my Black mare, and Sorrell Colt called Gibson, her Riding Saddle also my Negro woman called Nancy, and my Negro girl Choni, and all the Debts due me: likewise my Horse call'd Jack, to her, and her heirs and assigns.

I lend my loving wife the Plantation where I live, and the Ireland Field, and all the Land lying between the Road, and the lodging Branch, as far as Birds Line, and timber to support the same, as long as she lives; likewise I lend her the plantation lying on the Back Swamp, call'd the Orchard Field; with Timber adjoining to support the same during her Life.

Item. I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Noblin that part of Land that lies on the Back Swamp, and Short Swamp, beginning at a post Oak, in Peter Birds line, then by a line of marked trees, to Two small pines, on the path that lead down the Short Swamp then near N^o. along a line of marked Trees, to a Gum in a Branch, then by another line of marked trees to Poplar William Noblins Corner, to her, her heirs &c.

Corner, to her, her Heirs, I assigns for ever; also I give her my Negro
Woman Amey, and her Increase, to her and her Heirs, and assigns in
them. 3. I give and Bequeath unto my loving daughter Mary Barrow
the Remainder part of my plantation, and land that is not heretofore
given, or lent, to her and her heirs for ever, also my Negro woman
Milley, and her Child Sussy, two beds and bedsteads, one Cow, half
two cows, Six pewter plates, Two Basons, Two Dishes, Six pewter
Spoons, to her, her heirs, I assigns.

4th. I will that after my loving wife deceases, that I then give unto my
daughter, Mary Barrow, the Land lent to my wife, Except that lying
on the back, and Short Swamp, to her, and her Heirs for ever.

5th. I will that after my loving wife deceases, that I then give and Bequeath
unto my Daughter Lucy Hoblin, the land lent to my wife, lying on the
Short & Back Swamp, to her & her Heirs for ever.

6th. I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife, Two Beds & Turniture
Two Bedsteads, to her, her Heirs, and assigns.

7th. I lend unto my loving wife my Negro Boy Peter & all the Remain-
der part of my Estate that I have not before made mention of During her
Natural Life, and after her decease I give the Negro boy Peter to my
Daughter Mary Barrow, to her, and her Heirs, and assigns.

29th I will that all part of my Estate, tent to my loving wife & not given be-
fore be equally Divided after my loving wife Deceased, Between
my Two Daughters, Share & Share alike, Between them and their
Heirs and Assigns. &

And lastly I hereby appoint, My loving wife Exec^{tr} and William
Nobles, and Robert Barrow Executors of this my last Will and Testa-
ment, Revoking all former Wills, heretofore made by me, In,
Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand, and affixed my Seal,
this 4th Day of March 1787.

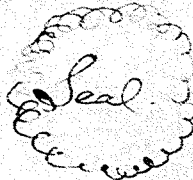
