Name of God Amen! I Christopher Pritchett now being
Sick and weak but of sound mind and Memory do
make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in
Manner and form following. Viz Item 1st I lend unto my beloved
Priscilla Pritchett all my whole Estate Lands Negroes &c.
excepting that part of my Lands herin given to my Sons
Jephtah and William Pritchett and the Negro Woman
Moriak and her Children now in possession of John Parker
Item 2nd I lend unto my Daughter Chloe Parker during her
Natural life one Negro Woman named Moriah and her
four Children namely Jim, Dave, Mary and Aggy together
with her future increase and at her Death that the said
Moriak and her increase be equally divided amongst the
Children of my said Daughter Chloe lawfully begotten of
her body and in Case that at my said Daughters Death she
has no living Children the Negroes aforesaid to return to
my Estate and that they be equally divided amongst the
rest of my Children and I further give to my said
Daughter Chloe one feather Bed and furniture and one Cow

which she hath already gotten together with all other
things which I let her take home with her after her Marriage
Item 3rd I give to my son Sephtham Pritchett all the Land which
was granted to me by Deed from Tife Read to him and his heirs
for ever Item 4th I give to my son William Pritchett all that Land
which was granted to me by Deed from William Hath and also
two parts which I have in the Lands that belongs to my son John
Pritchett dec^d to him and his heirs for ever Item 5 I give to my son
Christopher Pritchett all the rest of my Lands except the Land
deeded to me by John Pritchett to which his heirs and assigns for ever
and also the Negroe Woman Sarah and her son Isaac with all
her future increase to him his heirs and assigns for ever Item 6th I
give and bequeath to my son Sephtham Pritchett one Negroe Man
named Jacob to him his heirs and assigns for ever Item 7th I give
and bequeath to my son William Pritchett one Negroe Man named
Will and all such other property which I have already possessed
him with to him his heirs and assigns for ever Item 8th I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Mourning Pritchett one Negroe Woman

woman named Flora with present and future increase to her
and her heirs forever Item 9th I give and bequeath to
my Daughter Charity Pritchett one Negro Girl Dinah with all her
future increase and one new hunting Saddle of Lewis Daniel make
or of equal value with one of his mokes to be paid for of my estate to
her, her heirs and assigns forever Item 10th I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Polly Pritchett one Negro Girl Chary with all her future
increase and one new hunting Saddle of Lewis Daniel make or of
equal value with one of his mokes to be paid for of my estate to
her, her heirs and assigns forever Item 11th I give and bequeath to
my Daughter Sally Pritchett one Negro Girl named Polly and one
Negro Boy Isaac which I bought of Henry Jones with the future
increase of the said Polly to her and her heirs and assigns forever -
Item 12th My further Will and Desire is that after the Death of my
wife Priscilla the residue of my estate not herein otherwise disposed
of consisting of Stock Household furniture Plantation utensils &c
together with the tract of Land which I purchased of Sion Pritchett
be sold at Public Sale on a Credit of twelve months and
equally divided amongst my three Daughters namely Mourning
Charity and Polly after paying my just Debts Item 13th I con-

Charity and Polly after paying my just Debts, Item 13th I mean
that either of the negroes herein given to either of my before men-
tioned Daughters Mourning, Charity, Polly or Sally should die before
the Owner herein named comes to age of maturity or receives
the same then the loaner to be made good the Loss out of the
Residue of my estate which is herein provided to be equally
divided amongst my three Daughters Mourning Charity and Polly
in case no such accident ^{should} happen Item 14th I do hereby appoint
my son Jephthah Pritchett and my wife Priscilla Pritchett and
Mville Geo. Executors of this my last will and testament singularly
disallowing and disavowing all others by me in any wise made
hereby confirming and Ratifying this to be my last will Testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 28th day of Oct.
